# Markesan District Schools FACILITY STUDY FACT SHEET

A facility study is a proactive and strategic approach to ensuring our educational facilities are safe, functional, and adaptable to the evolving needs of both students and our community.

#### **FACILITY STUDY FINDINGS**

The facility study revealed our facilities are generally in "fair" condition with some areas rated as "good" and one marked as "poor."

The middle/high school exhibits better overall condition compared with the elementary school.

#### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

After conducting a facility study and engaging in community and staff input sessions, the following proposed improvements are recommended by the district for community consideration.

- New accessibility for Title on second story space
- ADA access to both floors
- Accommodate Special Education space needs
- Preliminary project budget range is \$35,900,000 \$40,600,000

- New office addition
- Renovate cafeteria
- Renovate middle school gym/auditorium
- Renovate middle school locker room
